Travel

- Cab Driver: 15-20% of the fare, plus \$1-2 per bag
- Skycap/Porter: \$1-3 per bag

Hotels

- Doorman/Bellhop: \$1-2 per bag, or for hailed taxi
- Concierge: \$5 for any special request fulfilled
- Housekeeping: \$2-3 per night, more for extra services
- Room Service: 15-20% of the bill, \$2-5 for special request

Dining

- Waitstaff: 15-20% of the bill
- Bartender: \$1-2 per drink, or 15-20% of the bill
- Host: No tip required. \$3-5 for any special request
- Buffet Staff: 5-10% of the bill
- Valet: \$2-5 upon retrieval of your car
- Coat Check: \$1 per coat
- Food Delivery: \$3-5 or 15-20% of the bill
- Bathroom Attendant: \$.50-2 for any service provided
- Take-Out: No tip required. \$1-3 for special requests. 5-10% of the bill for a large order.

Other

- Movers/Furniture: 5% of the bill, or \$10-20 per crew member
- Carwash: \$3-5 for any manual work done
- Regular Service Providers (mail carriers, trash collector, dog walker/per groomer, maid, personal trainer, etc.): \$10-30 around the holiday season. Some organizations forbid tipping, but non-monetary gifts may be allowed.
