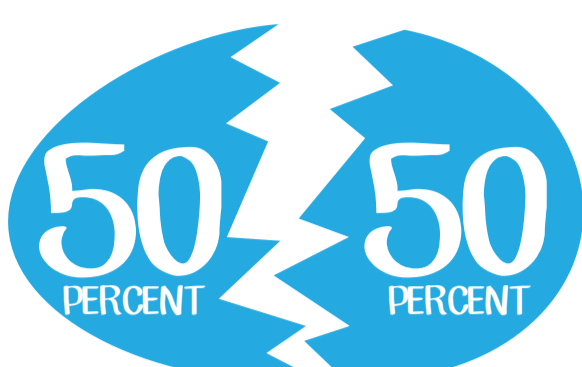

RESPONDENTS NOT SUPPORTING A CHILD OVER AGE 24

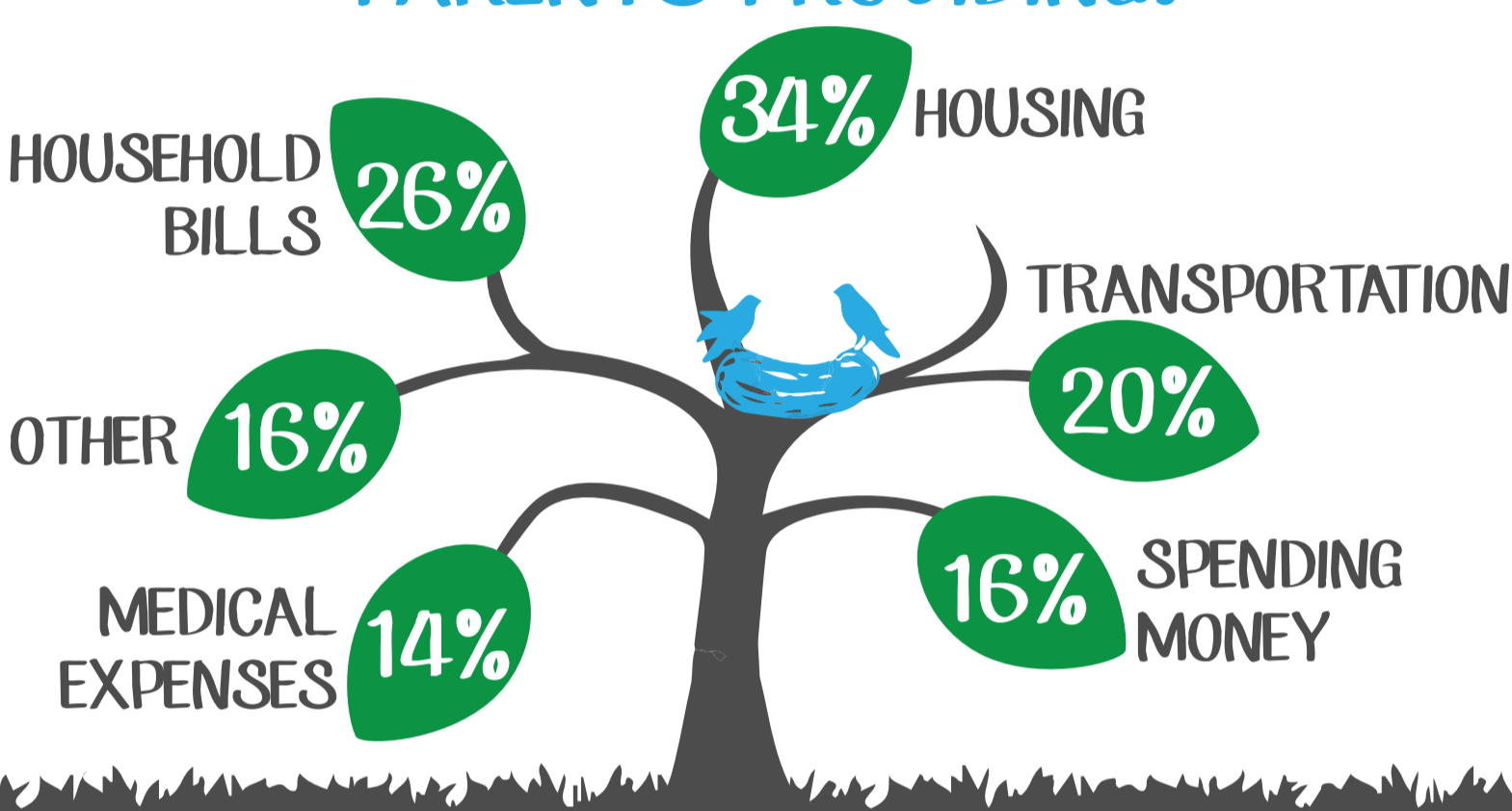
